TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

To allow access of emergency vehicles, we implement parking restrictions around the racecourse on racedays. This area is increased on our Sensational Racedays to include sections of Linkfield Road. To help reduce the traffic within Musselburgh we provide a free courtesy bus service from Wallyford and Newcraighall Park and Rides.

SECURITY क्ष SAFETY

We pride ourselves on providing a safe environment for all racegoers and staff on our raceday's. We present our raceday plans to the East Lothian Council Safety Advisory Group in November each year reviewing these throughout the year. On our Sensational 6 Raceday's we enhance our security provision, carry out additional bag searches and on occasion utilise sniffer dogs in order to reduce anti-social behaviour. On request from neighbours, we increase the presence of stewards in the streets around the racecourse while our racegoers arrive and leave.
