 Music and entertainment from 11:30 – 18:00 across the site. (Sunday only)


The Virgin Bet Queen's Cup on Easter Saturday – 4th April 2026

THE HORSE COMES FIRST

Horse welfare has always been of paramount importance to everyone at Musselburgh Racecourse, and now, more than ever, we want to highlight this to the general public by reaching out and welcoming you behind the scenes. Our team have put together an informative video to give you some

insight into how loved & looked after every horse is on a raceday. This has been endorsed by the RCA and is available to watch by scanning the QR code. Our team of experienced and dedicated ground staff ensures that horsemen, stable staff, jockeys, owners and trainers can be confident in running their horses at Musselburgh, knowing that every effort has been made to provide the best possible racing surface for their horses.



SECURITY & SAFETY

We pride ourselves on providing a safe environment for racegoers. We work with the East Lothian Council Safety Advisory Group, who sign off our annual plans in November with a further meeting in June specifically for Ladies Day. On our Sensational Raceday's we enhance our security numbers and have a Police presence in and around the course. On these days, we have increased bag searches and sniffer dogs to reduce anti-social behaviour. Our security footprint extends to the surrounding areas where we have a stewarding presence in the streets around the racecourse while our racegoers arrive and leave

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

To allow access of emergency vehicles, we implement parking restrictions around the racecourse on racedays. This area is

increased on our Sensational Racedays to include sections of Linkfield Road. To help reduce the traffic within Musselburgh we provide a free courtesy bus service from Wallyford and Newcraighall Park and Rides (when trains are running).
