For the avoidance of doubt, the owner must be in attendance with guests. Badges are strictly non-transferable and the owner must be in attendance and named on one of the four badges.

To enable us to ensure that all of the appropriate arrangements are in place and minimise risk for owners and prioritise the safety and well being of all attendees, we need you to provide us with the details of ALL those who will be attending no later than 4pm on the day before the race meeting (the card holder also needs to be named). Please use the Racecourse PASS concierge to do this, via www.rcapass.com. Syndicates and Racing Clubs, it will be the responsibility of the Syndicator/Club Manager to submit the names of those individuals attending the fixture.

For Racing Managers who require assistance registering attendance on behalf of owners please contact the PASS helpdesk. Children can attend as one of the four owners if pre-registered. All children attending will undergo the entry screening process as standard.

All bookings will automatically have a table reserved in the Queens Stand. Please note that the current guideline states that there can be no more than six people from more than two households per table. If your booking is more than two households and therefore require an additional table please contact me on the email below. Your meal will be served between 12 noon and 3pm.

Following changes to Government coronavirus requirements, we kindly ask owners to gather in no more than groups of six people at the racecourse. All owners and guests should continue to observe social distancing guidelines and wear face coverings on arrival at the racecourse and when indoors (if not eating or drinking). You must ensure you book your badges by following the booking guide above. If you have any other queries regarding badge allocation or table reservations please contact me via email.

Please note that if a horse is declared a non-runner, the owner should not attend the fixture.

- All owners are required to read the information and complete the personal health assessment <https://www.roa.co.uk/raceday/covid19/return.html> . You will also be required to complete health questions and a temperature check on arrival at the racecourse. If your temperature exceeds 37.8°C, you will not be granted access to the racecourse and will be advised to travel home.
- Owners will use the car park off Balcarres road. Then follow the walkway to the PASS and screening entrance. A map can be found on the Owners page of our web-site <https://www.musselburgh-racecourse.co.uk/owners-and-trainers>
- All owners, guests and representatives must bring Photo ID with them to the racecourse. It is not essential to bring your PASS Card.
- Owners on course will have access to a dedicated 'owners' zone', which will be separated from race day workers (trainers, stable staff, jockeys, officials, media etc.), who have undergone a more rigorous health screening process. For infection control purposes, no movement will be permitted between the two areas of the racecourse.

The Race day

The Owners entrance will open 1 hour before the first race.

On The Racecourse

The Owners zone will consist of:

- Owners carpark off Balcarres road,
- PASS entrance & Screening area
- One-way segregated walkway to and around the Queen's Stand
- Access to all areas within the Queen's Stand with a one-way system in operation (entry through main door, exit via the fire escapes from both Lothian Suite and first floor suites.
- Access to Lawn area to the front of the Queen Stand
- Access to the Owners Marquee with cash bar and lawn area
- Access to one set of stepping's at the paddock and the grandstand.
- No Access is permitted to the parade ring or the winners enclosure.

Adherence to physical distancing must be ensured, **please note that this remains 2m in Scotland and you must wear a face covering at all times.**

Briefing Areas

The Owners briefing area will be the stepping's between the Queens stand and the parade ring.

Catering

Owners Menu - served at your table in the Queens stand between 12 noon - 3pm.

SAMPLE MENU

To start

Homemade tomato and basil soup served with crusty bread

Or

Scottish garlic mushrooms served with a cream sauce and granary bread

Followed by

Beef and Guinness casserole served with new potatoes and vegetables

Or

Caramelised onion, feta & thyme frittata served with green leaves, homemade slaw and seasonal salad

And for dessert

Homemade apple pie served with cream

Or

Scottish cheese selection with chutney and Nairn oatcakes

Face Coverings

Face masks will be required at all times. They can only be removed while sitting down.

Betting Facilities

BritBet will be located in the Queens stand.

Departure Process

Following the conclusion of your race(s), owners are asked to leave the racecourse within an hour to allow for all owners to be accommodated.

Musselburgh will operate a one-way system so owners can return to their vehicle without crossing paths with others and hand hygiene stations will be provided on exit. Upon leaving the racecourse, wristbands for the race day should be removed by the owner and disposed of by racecourse staff. Wristbands cannot be retained for future use.

If an owner leaves the racecourse and wishes to re-enter they will be required to go through the screening process again.
